FIXTURES AT GLEVUM PARK



- ATTENDANCE
 - 1. Admittance to Glevum Park is only permitted on the basis that the conditions in this notice are fully complied with. Any failure to observe these conditions will result in admittance being denied and/or individuals being asked to leave the site.
 - 2. Any spectators will only be permitted to attend any fixture at Glevum Park in line with guidance from the DCMS and Football Association. A separate notice is available to support the safe management of spectator numbers at Glevum Park. As at 11 April no spectators are permitted to attend fixtures.
 - 3. Wherever possible, anyone attending Glevum Park will either scan the NHS App QR Code on entry or provide their contact details, to ensure compliance with Test & Trace requirements are captured. Where this is not possible, written details should be provided to our volunteers on entry to the site.

IN ADVANCE

- 4. All visiting teams are expected to read this notice in advance and share it openly with club officials, players and any other representatives of the visiting team.
- 5. Similarly, visiting officials are expected to familiarise themselves with this notice, in full. Where the match Referee has appointed the Assistant Referees, they will ensure that this has been shared with other officials.
- 6. Visiting clubs and match officials will be expected to report any known Covid-19 issues (such as recent contact with someone who has contracted the virus after attending a training session) in advance. It is anticipated that visiting clubs and officials will follow the FA guidance in relation to Covid-19 in terms of transport and other arrangements outside the control of Tuffley Rovers AFC.

UPON ARRIVAL

- 7. Upon arrival at Glevum Park, all visitors will be expected to provide contact details (where they have not been provided in advance) to ensure compliance with the Test & Trace system and will also be subject to a temperature check. Anyone with a temperature at or above 37.8 degrees (Celsius) will not be granted access to the site.
- 8. We would ask visitors to access our site via Lower Tuffley Lane and park on site, where possible. We will have a car-park attendant available, who will look to ensure that cars park appropriately, to take account of social distancing requirements.
- 9. We will look to apply a one-way system for those accessing (and who exit) the site via the carpark. We ask all visitor to comply with this requirement.

CHANGING ROOMS

10. Our changing rooms will be cleaned between all fixtures.

- 11. In most circumstances our changing rooms will not be used during fixtures.
- 12. Where it is agreed, in advance, that the changing rooms will be used there is a strict maximum that no more than four players and/or officials will be allowed in the changing rooms at any time.
- 13. Anyone entering the changing room building will need to wear a face covering at all times, whether in the corridor, changing rooms or in the private toilet areas.
- 14. Match officials will be given access to two changing rooms. No more than three officials will be granted entry to one room at any time.
- 15. Changing rooms will be 'out of bounds' during games and are not accessible at half-time. Players and coaches should not ask for access during the game, if substituted or otherwise leaving the field of play.

BOARDROOM

16. Until such time as restrictions are lifted, there will be no access to the boardroom, either before the fixture or at half-time. If visiting officials make themselves known to Tuffley Rovers officials, refreshments will be made available to them, to be served outside.

DURING THE MATCH

- 17. There will be no admittance to the changing rooms *during* the game, in any circumstances.
- 18. The available dugout seats will be reduced in number and marked where they should not be used. Where this leaves insufficient room for substitutes or members of the coaching/management team, excess numbers should be asked to sit in another area of the ground.
- 19. Match-balls will be cleaned frequently during the game. In addition, hand sanitiser will be available to all participants, at all times.
- 20. Social distancing should be observed at all times during breaks in play.

AFTER THE MATCH

- 21. Changing room will become accessible at full-time but restrictions on numbers and all other requirements will continue to be observed at all times.
- 22. It is preferable that showers are not in use. Where they are used, no more than two players or officials will be permitted to use the showers at any one time.

- 23. Social distancing requirements shall be observed at all times, whether in the bar, when serving post-match refreshments or on exiting the site.
- 24. Where possible, post-match food will be served as take-away portions.

LEAVING THE SITE

- 25. Please treat our volunteers with respect at all times. Where one-way systems are in place they should be strictly observed.
- 26. Where it is not possible to strictly adopt a one-way system, all attendees should take responsibility for adhering to social distancing requirements.
