# FROM THE EDITOR:



Welcome to all our visitors to Glevum Park this afternoon, notably the players, management team, committee and supporters of Westfields FC. Welcome, also, to this afternoon's match officials.

It is always a pleasure to welcome Andy Morris and his colleagues at Westfields to Glevum Park. Andy has to be one of the nicest people to be involved in Hellenic League football and he is incredibly passionate about his club. I say 'his club' because Andy has been there for Westfields since their inception (initially as a Sunday club). That is commitment of the highest order and Andy is a legend!

As nice a guy as Andy is, I hope we make his day unenjoyable! His team had that effect on me back in September when they defeated us 7-2 (a game that Muzzy and Booner have described in their articles).

If we can avenge that defeat, we would record a third consecutive win, as part of a run of results that probably sums up our season! A win today would mean we had defeated Corsham Town, Pershore Town and Westfields consecutively; after losing consecutively to Royal Wootton Bassett Town, Cribbs and Highworth Town. With respect to the last three clubs named (the first three games in chronological order), our last three games have arguably been the tougher challenges! Before those six games we held Cinderford Town to a draw – when we should have won – and they are now the form side in the League!

A good consistent run of performances and results is what we need in our last nine competitive fixtures of the season if we are to achieve the pre-season aspiration to exceed last year's points haul and finish in the top-half of the table. We currently sit in seventh place, 12 points shy of our best haul in our modern Hellenic League history (since re-joining the Premier Division in 2015/16), so our objectives are still achievable, even though our current position owes something to having played more games than some of the sides sitting below us.

Remaining competitive until the last kick of the season is imperative if we are to meet our objectives and that starts with making sure a tough opponent is vanquished today. Andy Morris will be hoping for a very different result!

I hope everyone enjoys the game. Safe travels home.

# TUFFLEY ROVERS CLUB HISTORY



The late Donald E Hall founded Tuffley Rovers FC in 1929. The Club's Headquarters were in a former railway carriage, which served as Mr Hall's Boot and Shoe repair shop on the Stroud Road at Tuffley in the City Of Gloucester. The Club started its playing life in the North Gloucestershire League. Senior XI Championship honours include that of the North Gloucestershire League and Stroud and District League (4 times) and in 1987/1988 the Club were Champions of the Gloucestershire Northern Senior League and gained promotion to the Gloucestershire County League.

After two seasons of consolidation the Club won the County League Title in 1990/1991, their application to join the Hellenic League was successful and they were accepted into Hellenic Division One. Progress continued as in the 1992/1993 season Rovers were Champions of Division One and also Division One League Cup Winners and after promotion competed in the Premier Division of the Hellenic League from 1993/1994, regularly finishing in the top half of the table. The 1998/1999 season saw Tuffley win the Norman Matthew's Floodlit Cup defeating Carterton Town in the final. Whilst the Club enjoyed this success, the 2nd XI and 3rd XI also gained promotion and championship honours. The 1998/1999 season saw the 2nd XI win the Northern Senior League and reach the finals of both the County Cup and League Cup, unfortunately losing out on both occasions. Promotion, however, was not possible as reserve teams were not allowed at that point to enter the Gloucestershire County League and progress further up the pyramid system.

The Club continued to thrive in the Hellenic League and managed to win the Floodlit Cup again in the 2002/2003 season defeating Brackley Town over two legs in the final. However, the ever-changing ground grading requirements, if the club was to remain in the Hellenic League, and the financial strain these improvements imposed on the Club forced Tuffley Rovers to make the decision to withdraw from the Hellenic League in 2005 and settle for local football in Gloucestershire.

After a difficult start Rovers were crowned champions of Division 2 of the Northern Senior League in the 2005/2006 season and were promoted to Division 1. After a slow start the team put together a consistent run and managed to claim the Division 1 Title as well as win the GFA Senior Amateur Cup and reach the final of the Reg Davis Memorial League Cup.

A return to the Gloucestershire County League followed and the club finished a very creditable 4th place (2007/8) but the summer of 2008 saw a number of senior players retire. Over the next few seasons, an evolving squad finished 11<sup>th</sup>, 3<sup>rd</sup>, 6<sup>th</sup> and 3<sup>rd</sup> in the County League, before the 2012/13 Season marked an improvement for the club. After challenging for league championship honours all season, the club couldn't quite maintain the form to secure the title, finishing second. However, this was enough to gain promotion to the Hellenic League Division One (West) for the 2013/14 season.

On their return to the Hellenic League, The Rovers saw a season that witnessed some turmoil – including the departure of manager, Doug Foxwell – to record a decent sixth place finish and some good cup results. This was followed up with the Runners'-up spot in 2014/15 and promotion back to the Hellenic Premier Division, exactly ten years after they had withdrawn from the League.

The first season saw a struggle against relegation, ultimately resulting in the resignation of Warren Evans as manager, before the club retained their status due to a vacancy in the league, after finishing 17<sup>th</sup>. Mark Pritchett was then appointed as Player/Manager and took the side to consecutive 10<sup>th</sup> placed finishes, before a 15<sup>th</sup> place finish in 2018/19. Two pandemic affected seasons then passed, with Pritchett leaving the club part-way through. Rich Cox took over as Manager for a single season, but resigned midway through 2021/22 after a disastrous run of results. Former Manchester United player Neil Mustoe then took over, steering the club away from danger (finishing in 17<sup>th</sup> place).

Mustoe achieved an 18<sup>th</sup> place finish at the end of the 2022/23 season, his first full campaign, before achieving a healthy 14<sup>th</sup> place in 2023/24, with a much improved squad. The 2024/25 season ended with further improvement, as Mustoe's squad finished in 11<sup>th</sup> place.

# FROM THE MANAGER:



Good afternoon and welcome to all players, coaches, management and supporters from Westfields FC.

We go into this afternoon's game full of confidence after back-to-back wins over Corsham Town and Pershore Town, scoring six goals in the process and creating plenty of opportunities.

Looking at the form table, it can be manipulated to suit any agenda at times, depending on whether you focus on the short or longer term — but there's no doubt we are in a good place over the last few months.

We are still hurting from the previous encounter with Westfields, which was a bizarre game of football. We played really well, created chances without taking them, and combined that with conceding some very poor goals. Alongside some excellent finishing from the opposition, it led to a heavy defeat.

Today is not about revenge. It's about what we have learned, how far we have progressed in all aspects since then, and continuing our push to finish as high as possible this season.

Once again, we'll look closely at the starting eleven. Although we have a small squad, competition for places is there. We have a few players back from unavailability and suspension, which makes us as strong as we can be — aside from the injured players who would further strengthen us if available.

Last week we changed a winning team, with Callum McLean and Jorrel Sanniola extremely unlucky not to start. However, with Sam Kelly available again, it was a case of round pegs in round holes and ensuring the right balance to the team. This week may well see further changes. Every game is different, and we need to utilise the squad to its maximum over the remaining fixtures.

Hopefully we can secure a third straight win and move beyond the forty-point mark for the season.



# PLAYER PROFILES 2025/26

## **Luke Merchant**

### **Goalkeeper**

Club captain who returned to the club in the 2022/23 season, after a Hellenic League Premier Division title winning season at Bishops Cleeve. A great shot stopper, commanding presence and accomplished keeper. Holds the club record for Hellenic League appearances as a keeper.

## **Alex Hammond**

### **Goalkeeper**

Join the club in late-October following a serious injury to Luke Merchant and has been a fantastic replacement. Had previously been with Mangotsfield United and is studying at Hartpury. Is a good all-round keeper, with safe hands, good shot stopping and can play with his feet.

## **Robin Hoffland**

### **Goalkeeper**

A long-serving player, despite his age, who acts as a capable back-up to Luke Merchant in goal, whenever needed. Has played for the club's 1sts, 2nds, 3rds, 4ths and 5ths, as well as the U18s and always gives his all. Reliable, in a word.

## **Callum McLean**

### **Defence**

New signing, who has impressed at right-back in pre-season and could prove to be a great addition to the squad. Tough tackling and comfortable on the ball. Came through the U18s at local rivals Longlevens.

## **Elijah Simpson**

### **Defence**

Player under Neil Mustoe at Gloucester City U18s and joined from Brimscombe & Thrupp for 2024/25. Comfortable on the ball when in possession, shows a turn of pace, and good defensively. One of the leaders in the squad.

## **Sam Kelly**

### **Defence**

A cultured, ball playing centre-half who can also play at full-back, who has been a great addition to the squad. Joined from Hartpury after a season at Longlevens in 2024/25. Has impressed since donning the claret and blue this season.

## **Mark Pritchett**

### **Defence**

Tasted Hellenic League title success at Bishops Cleeve. Previously at Rovers as Player / Manager before stepping away from the role in 21/22. Offers a no nonsense, old-fashioned approach in each game and is a threat in the opposition box.

## **Macaulay Herbert**

### **Defence**

Our second longest-serving member of the squad. 'Macca' came through our U18s and is solid and dependable; an excellent defender who has been getting better with every season that passed. Has made over 300 first team appearances, despite several injuries punctuating each season.

## **Ellis Clifford**

### **Defence**

Came through the U18s squad, after joining from Gloucester City's youth set-up. Made a breakthrough in 2023/24 and has now amassed almost 60 appearances at left-back. An improving and emerging talent.

## **Harley Mustoe**

### **Defence/Midfield**

Has gained experience playing County League football for Hardwicke and has held down a regular first team spot after making his debut as a substitute in our first game of 2024/25. Most comfortable in midfield but has played at full-back and looked very accomplished. Young Player of the Year 2024/25.

## **Callum McGuirk**

### **Defence/Midfield**

Signed from Longlevens in 2022, where he'd largely been used at full-back, he is a hard-working midfielder, who looks comfortable on the ball. Played academy football during his earlier years, including a spell at Bristol City. Has become a vital part of the squad.

## **Corey Warrington**

### **Midfield**

Signed at the start of 2024/25 after excelling at Northern Senior League side Tredworth Tigers during 2023/24. A highly energetic midfielder who likes to get on the ball and is well regarded in local football. A real talent.

## **Liam Smith**

### **Midfield**

Has Southern League experience. Calm in possession and possesses a good passing range, although injuries have limited his progress.

## **Mason Preston**

### **Midfield**

Former Forest Green Rovers Academy player recently signed from Hereford Pegasus. Diminutive figure who already looks to be a great addition. Great feet and good energy!

**Warren Mann****Midfield**

Our longest serving player with 543 competitive games at Step 7 and above over a 20 year period. The player opposition players, officials and supporters love to hate! Has played in all positions over the last few seasons and happy to play wherever needed.

**Kieran Alder****Midfield/Forward**

Returned to the club in 2022/23, after spells with Cinderford, Bishops Cleeve and Worcester City; and overcame injuries to return to his best. # WESTFIELDS FC CLUB HISTORY



Westfields Football Club commenced the new 2025/2026 season again in the UHL Hellenic League Premier Division having played last season and finished 13th despite great ambitions to finish in a promotion place.

Westfields are full of optimism of finishing in a much higher place this season and hope to challenge for a promotion place to step for. Last season was disappointing, not only in the league but we also reached two cup finals, sadly losing on penalties to Kempsey FC in the HFA County Senior Challenge Cup and losing to Cirencester Town in the two-legged Wiseman Floodlit Hellenic League Cup Final.

This season Westfields have introduced a new manager in Dan Moon a former player at Westfields and an ex-Hereford Lads Club Manager who is well known in local circles and has a good range of experience and knowledge of the local playing talent.

During the last 59 years Westfields have enjoyed a meteoric rise throughout the West Midland League to the Midland Football League and along the way have finished runners up twice in the Midland Football League and narrowly missed out on promotion to the Southern League South and West. Westfields celebrated their 50th anniversary season in 2016/2017 with an amazing giant killing run in the FA Cup, which saw them go through to the first round proper before losing to Curzon Ashton, following a Match of the Day game at Allpay Park in the first round proper.

This also featured Westfields appearance on Football Focus and prior to that Chief Executive Andy Morris has appeared live on the FA Cup draw as a studio panel guest in Manchester. Westfields have enjoyed tremendous support financially and first being sponsored by their ground sponsor Allpay Limited who for the first 15 years were the shirt sponsors, this has now been taken over by CJ Insurance who have enjoyed fantastic support and coverage in the last 6 seasons. In addition, Westfields are supported by Metclad of Nottingham, Support Air and Bloor Homes along with support from life member Ron Marshall, who continues to support the club he has known since the origination in 1966.

Westfields are a club geared up to success with a very strong committee which has been well established over many years although in the last closed season we have lost two tremendous committee workers in President Graham Preece and former Chairman Chris Williams who have sadly both passed away. Westfields have a ground for higher graded football and a recent refurbished clubroom, bar and dressing room.

# N (OR AROUND) THIS DAY IN HISTORY...

Current records date back, fairly accurately, to the 2007/08 season and although there are a few gaps stopping us having a full set of data, it gives us the opportunity to include this programme feature that allows us to reflect on days gone by and fixtures on, or around, today's date.

Since those records began, we've had three previous games on 21 February, so we've included those in this review alongside other games around the date, to reflect on our fortunes over the years ....

## 21 February 2009

Tuffley Rovers slumped to an emphatic defeat at Kings Stanley in the Gloucestershire County League, with the victory for the hosts, keeping them in contention for the title.

This 5–1 victory got off the ground in the 20<sup>th</sup> minute when Mike Beckingham opened the scoring. A few minutes later Stanley were 2 – 0 up through Steve Potter, then in the 35<sup>th</sup> minute Luke Barstow netted a third. Five minutes into the second half Beckingham netted his second to make it 4–0.

Stanley were still not satisfied and Nick Reiger scored in the 70<sup>th</sup> minute. Rovers, who had been outplayed throughout the game, snatched a consolation goal in the dying minutes through Dan Gillespie.

Tuffley Rovers returned from Carterton with a 6-1 victory in the UHlsport Hellenic League, Division One (West), boosting their hopes to win the league in the process. Goals from Kieran Squires, Jordan Fletcher, Macaulay Herbert, Brett James, Shayne Bradley and a Marcus Foxwell penalty ensured Warren Evans' side returned from Oxfordshire with all three points.

However, midway through the second period Rovers levelled when Warren Mann showed good strength to win the ball, before crossing to Shayne Bradley. Although the veteran striker couldn't direct the ball goalwards, he did win the ball, which looped over to Jamie Goodwin and he headed the ball into the bottom corner of the Binfield net, from 10 yards, to level scores.



Both sides had chances to win the game but it ultimately ended all square.
