

## **TUFFLEY ROVERS CLUB HISTORY**

The late Donald E Hall founded Tuffley Rovers FC in 1929. The Club's Headquarters were in a former railway carriage, which served as Mr Hall's Boot and Shoe repair shop on the Stroud Road at Tuffley in the City Of Gloucester. The Club started its playing life in the North Gloucestershire League. Senior XI Championship honours include that of the North Gloucestershire League and



Stroud and District League (4 times) and in 1987/1988 the Club were Champions of the Gloucestershire Northern Senior League and gained promotion to the Gloucestershire County League.

After two seasons of consolidation the Club won the County League Title in 1990/1991, their application to join the Hellenic League was successful and they were accepted into Hellenic Division One. Progress continued as in the 1992/1993 season Rovers were Champions of Division One and also Division One League Cup Winners and after promotion competed in the Premier Division of the Hellenic League from 1993/1994, regularly finishing in the top half of the table. The 1998/1999 season saw Tuffley win the Norman Matthew's Floodlit Cup defeating Carterton Town in the final. Whilst the Club enjoyed this success, the 2nd XI and 3rd XI also gained promotion and championship honours. The 1998/1999 season saw the 2nd XI win the Northern Senior League and reach the finals of both the County Cup and League Cup, unfortunately losing out on both occasions. Promotion, however, was not possible as reserve teams were not allowed at that point to enter the Gloucestershire County League and progress further up the pyramid system.

The Club continued to thrive in the Hellenic League and managed to win the Floodlit Cup again in the 2002/2003 season defeating Brackley Town over two legs in the final. However, the ever-changing ground grading requirements, if the club was to remain in the Hellenic League, and the financial strain these improvements imposed on the Club forced Tuffley Rovers to make the decision to withdraw from the Hellenic League in 2005 and settle for local football in Gloucestershire.

After a difficult start Rovers were crowned champions of Division 2 of the Northern Senior League in the 2005/2006 season and were promoted to Division 1. After a slow start the team put together a consistent run and managed to claim the Division 1 Title as well as win the GFA Senior Amateur Cup and reach the final of the Reg Davis Memorial League Cup.

A return to the Gloucestershire County League followed and the club finished a very creditable 4th place (2007/8) but the summer of 2008 saw a number of senior players retire. Over the next few seasons, an evolving squad finished 11<sup>th</sup>, 3<sup>rd</sup>, 6<sup>th</sup> and 3<sup>rd</sup> in the County League, before the 2012/13 Season marked an improvement for the club. After challenging for league championship honours all season, the club couldn't quite maintain the form to secure the title, finishing second. However, this was enough to gain promotion to the Hellenic League Division One (West) for the 2013/14 season.

On their return to the Hellenic League, The Rovers saw a season that witnessed some turmoil – including the departure of manager, Doug Foxwell – to record a decent sixth place finish and some good cup results. This was followed up with the Runners'-up spot in 2014/15 and promotion back to the Hellenic Premier Division, exactly ten years after they had withdrawn from the League.

The first season saw a struggle against relegation, ultimately resulting in the resignation of Warren Evans as manager, before the club retained their status due to a vacancy in the league, after finishing 17<sup>th</sup>. Mark Pritchett was then appointed as Player/Manager and took the side to consecutive 10<sup>th</sup> placed finishes, before a 15<sup>th</sup> place finish in 2018/19. Two pandemic affected seasons then passed, with Pritchett leaving the club part-way through. Rich Cox took over as Manager for a single season, but resigned midway through 2021/22 after a disastrous run of results. Former Manchester United player Neil Mustoe then took over, steering the club away from danger (finishing in 17<sup>th</sup> place).

Mustoe achieved an 18<sup>th</sup> place finish at the end of the 2022/23 season, his first full campaign, before achieving a healthy 14<sup>th</sup> place in 2023/24, with a much improved squad.

### WESTFIELDS FOOTBALL CLUB SEASON 2024-2025 MANAGEMENT, STAFF AND PLAYERS

SCOTT RUSSELL – JOINT MANAGER Scott joined us early last season and after a baptism of fire, he settled down and steadied the ship very, very well. He made a number of important signings and also appointed Assistant Manager Nik Morgan, and along with Dan Chance, and Physio Tiago Virana, they produced a very hard-working management team. Scott had previously managed Monmouth Town and Builth Wells Town, as well as being goalkeeping coach at Lincoln City and Hereford United in his earlier days. Scott works for the Herefordshire Football Association.

NIK MORGAN – JOINT MANAGER Nik was appointed by Scott Russell as Assistant Manager last year, and he quickly became actively involved and made a number of important recommendations for players to join Westfields FC. Nik provided great support to Scott and the management team and has now been appointed Joint Manager for the 2024-2025 season. Nik is a UEFA B licenced coach.

LEE KENDALL – HEAD COACH Lee joins us from Barry Town where he enjoyed 2 previous seasons as manager and coach. Lee is an experienced coach that has done extremely well. As a player, Lee enjoyed football league experience has a goalkeeper and also is recognised as one of the top non-league coaches in the area.

DAN CHANCE – ASSISTANT COACH Dan joined us at the same time as Scott Russell last year, and has proved a tremendous member of the team, with good coaching ability.

TIAGO VIRANA – PHYSIO Tiago joined us at the same time as Scott Russell last year and proved a capable member of the team to provide qualified physio help on match days and on training nights.

KIERON BLACKBURN Goalkeeper, who returned to the club at for the 2nd half of the 2013-14 season after a successful spell at Malvern Town, part of the club's FA Cup adventure in 2016-17 when we reached the 1st round proper only to lose a replay to Curzon Ashton, a great character on and off the pitch

SHAY STERRY Goalkeeper, A very talented young keeper on loan from Hereford FC, made his debut for Fields last season away at Mangotsfield before returning Hereford FC to play in a number of FA Trophy games.

GEORGE CLARKE Defender, a hugely popular lad who came into the club November 2023 from Abergavenny Town, a box-to-box player who loves defending and is one of the fittest in the club, a great lad for a social night out.

JAC EVANS Defender, another popular player who leads by example with his brilliant attitude on and off the Field, a real winner who joined in November 2023 from Abergavenny Town FC.

CAM DAVIES Defender, hard to believe this lad is still only 18, won an almost clean sweep of awards in 2023-24 season with the Supporters, Managers & players player of the year awards, a player with his feet firmly on the ground and all the attributes to have a long and successful career in football, now in his 3rd year at the club.

BRANDON JENNINGS Defender, after years of trying to sign him from our neighbours Hfd Lads Club it was great when he joined us at the end of season 23-24, a great addition to our squad with his ability in both boxes and a super left foot.

JOEL EDWARDS Defender, a hugely experienced player who is back from a nasty ankle injury which has plagued him for a few years and limited his playing time, a former captain of HFC and Welsh Premier player with Cardiff Met University, a brilliant character on and off the pitch

LUKE SYLVESTER Defender, rejoined the club after a successful number of seasons away at Barry Town winning a league and cup double, a very fit lad who loves getting forward and creating chances.

SAM HUNT Defender, has recently rejoined the club after a spell away at the now dissolved Hereford Lads Club, a very fit left back who is a box-to-box player with an eye for goal from set pieces.

CALLUM NOWELL Defender, a strong young defender who joined the club in last season however is appearances were restricted, played for Hereford in the Community under 18's, will be looking to play his way into the 1st team this season.

DAN STONEMAN Winger, our longest serving player who after a very brief spell away at Cribbs in the Southern League last season returned to Fields and helped turn our fortunes back around, a proper menace to defenders with his ability to go past people and create and score goals, great to have both on and off the pitch with his aura and character.

ARCHIE MUIRHEAD Winger, now into his 3rd season with the club having joined from Worcester City, another technically gifted player with a lovely left foot and an ability to glide past defenders to score and create goals.

HARRISON SUMMERS Winger, a talented winger who is now in his 2nd consecutive season with the club having secured a year's contract at HFC after his 1st season with the club in season 2021-22, a top young talent who just loves playing football. SAM MUIRHEAD Winger, came in last season to train with the squad having had time away from the game but quickly became an important part of the squad, the brother of Archie he has hit the ground running in preseason and likely to play an important part this season with his pace and ability to create goals.

MASON GODSALL Midfield, another young player who joined from neighbours Hfd Lads Club after impressing against Fields in several games, a no-nonsense midfielder who has a great range of short- and long-range passes, has been a great addition to the club and a player who could have a big season

NATHAN DAVIES Midfield, joined the club from Abergavenny Town in November 2023, a very popular player and extremely talented midfield player who shows great composure on the ball with a good range of passing, a big player for us moving forward.

DAI THOMAS Midfield, recently joined the club from Welsh side Cambrian United, a very fit all action midfield player who likes to break up attacks and begin attacks, a great addition to the squad.

LUKE WILLIAMS (SPOOKY) Midfield, another player to join us in 23-24 season having previously played at Abergavenny Town FC, a leader on the pitch whose appearances were limited last season but will prove to be a big asset as we go into the season TOM ROGERS Midfield, former captain of Chippenham Academy rejoined Fields towards the end of last season, a strong player who is a good passer of the ball and likes to get forward.

CAMERON KEETCH Attacker, Joined the club at the start of the current season after being voted player of the season for his club Cambrian United, a left footed player who can play in several attacking positions with his ability to score and create goals, another good addition to the squad.

OLI BARNES Striker, after joining the club and hitting the ground running in season 23-24 an ankle injury prevented him for challenging for the leagues golden boot award, however he still led the goalscoring charts for Fields, a striker who loves scoring goals, a very popular player amongst the squad who has a huge part to play this season.

JAMES HANCOCK Striker, joined the club for preseason after several seasons at Hereford Lads Club, a player admired by the club for several seasons with his ability to not give any time to defenders and an ability to chip in with goals.

BEN BROOK Striker, recently joined the club from Step 4 side Melksham Town where he was a regular goal scorer last season, a much sought after striker who will add experience, hard work and additional strength to our front line.

## WESTFIELDS FC HISTORY



Westfields Football Club commenced the new 2024/25 season again in the UHL Hellenic League Premier Division, having played last season and finished twelfth, despite great ambitions to finish in a promotion place.

Last season, Westfields reshuffled their management team and brought in a new look team involving Scott Russell; Dan Chance; and Nik Morgan, and this year have added former football league goalkeeper and Welsh experience manager, Lee Kendall, as head coach.

Westfields are full of optimism in finishing in a much higher place this season and hope to challenge for promotion to Step 4. Last season, Westfields had to reorganise their playing staff, as well as the management staff, but everything went to good effect and a good number of progressive youngsters were brought into the side, alongside the experience of Westfields long established players.

This has now been taken over by CJ Insurance, who have enjoyed fantastic support and coverage in the last 5 seasons during the period in the Hellenic Football League as Westfields' official club sponsor. In addition, Westfields are supported byMetclad of Nottingham, Support Air and Bloor Homes, along with support from life member Ron Marshall, who continues to support the club he has known since it's in origination in 1966.

Westfields are a club geared up to success with a very strong committee, which has been well established over many years, and with a ground with an e-certificate for higher graded football, and a recent refurbished clubroom, bar, and dressing rooms.


