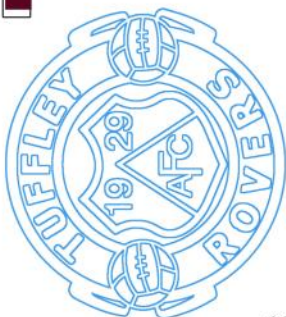

FROM THE EDITOR

Our visitors today are a good club, run by good people, and they've had some tough times over the past 2 or 3 years, both on and off the field.

I still write this expecting to see Allan Boulton, John Mutton and other familiar (and friendly faces) who were ever present when our two clubs met in the past. Sadly, neither Allan or John is still with us, but such was their impact and presence that I still anticipate seeing them because they were synonymous with their club. That is one of the things that makes this level of the game so fantastic; the people.

Times change and the people attached to clubs change, and so do our fortunes. When Allan and John were at the helm it was during a time when Brimscombe & Thrupp were ascending the leagues. That isn't a negative reflection on those now running the club; it is just an observation in the context of their current situation. As we experience a positive direction of travel, our friends at Brimscombe are experiencing tougher times. A change of management team at the end of last season, was quickly followed by another, then another and they are having to rebuild the side and the club. We have been there and know that pain.

In midweek I had some time to go and watch the game between Longlevens and Lydney Town at Sawmills End. Both sides are, like Brimscombe & Thrupp, fighting for Hellenic League Premier Division survival, with Malmesbury Victoria not far behind. It promises to be a close run thing for all four sides, with each having the chance to survive, but equally knowing that every point is incredibly precious. On Wednesday evening, Lee Smith's Lydney were comfortable in winning 2-0, which dragged Levens a little closer to the relegation places and gave Lydney some much needed momentum for a move up the table.

The impact for today's visitors is that they need to win their final two games – here today and against Longlevens on Wednesday – if they are to survive. Anything but a win here today will see them all but consigned to relegation. If they defeat us today (and they come into this game on an improved run of form) and they have a cup final on Wednesday!

Of course, as much as I like our visitors today, my hope is for a Tuffley Rovers victory. Saturdays are always better when your team wins.

TUFFLEY ROVERS CLUB HISTORY



The late Donald E Hall founded Tuffley Rovers FC in 1929. The Club's Headquarters were in a former railway carriage, which served as Mr Hall's Boot and Shoe repair shop on the Stroud Road at Tuffley in the City Of Gloucester. The Club started its playing life in the North Gloucestershire League. Senior XI Championship honours include that of the North Gloucestershire League and Stroud and District League (4 times) and in 1987/1988 the Club were Champions of the Gloucestershire Northern Senior League and gained promotion to the Gloucestershire County League.

After two seasons of consolidation the Club won the County League Title in 1990/1991, their application to join the Hellenic League was successful and they were accepted into Hellenic Division One. Progress continued as in the 1992/1993 season Rovers were Champions of Division One and also Division One League Cup Winners and after promotion competed in the Premier Division of the Hellenic League from 1993/1994, regularly finishing in the top half of the table. The 1998/1999 season saw Tuffley win the Norman Matthew's Floodlit Cup defeating Carterton Town in the final. Whilst the Club enjoyed this success, the 2nd XI and 3rd XI also gained promotion and championship honours. The 1998/1999 season saw the 2nd XI win the Northern Senior League and reach the finals of both the County Cup and League Cup, unfortunately losing out on both occasions. Promotion, however, was not possible as reserve teams were not allowed at that point to enter the Gloucestershire County League and progress further up the pyramid system.

The Club continued to thrive in the Hellenic League and managed to win the Floodlit Cup again in the 2002/2003 season defeating Brackley Town over two legs in the final. However, the ever-changing ground grading requirements, if the club was to remain in the Hellenic League, and the financial strain these improvements imposed on the Club forced Tuffley Rovers to make the decision to withdraw from the Hellenic League in 2005 and settle for local football in Gloucestershire.

After a difficult start Rovers were crowned champions of Division 2 of the Northern Senior League in the 2005/2006 season and were promoted to Division 1. After a slow start the team put together a consistent run and managed to claim the Division 1 Title as well as win the GFA Senior Amateur Cup and reach the final of the Reg Davis Memorial League Cup.

A return to the Gloucestershire County League followed and the club finished a very creditable 4th place (2007/8) but the summer of 2008 saw a number of senior players retire. Over the next few seasons, an evolving squad finished 11th, 3rd, 6th and 3rd in the County League, before the 2012/13 Season marked an improvement for the club. After challenging for league championship honours all season, the club couldn't quite maintain the form to secure the title, finishing second. However, this was enough to gain promotion to the Hellenic League Division One (West) for the 2013/14 season.

On their return to the Hellenic League, The Rovers saw a season that witnessed some turmoil – including the departure of manager, Doug Foxwell – to record a decent sixth place finish and some good cup results. This was followed up with the Runners'-up spot in 2014/15 and promotion back to the Hellenic Premier Division, exactly ten years after they had withdrawn from the League.

The first season saw a struggle against relegation, ultimately resulting in the resignation of Warren Evans as manager, before the club retained their status due to a vacancy in the league, after finishing 17th. Mark Pritchett was then appointed as Player/Manager and took the side to consecutive 10th placed finishes, before a 15th place finish in 2018/19. Two pandemic affected seasons then passed, with Pritchett leaving the club part-way through. Rich Cox took over as Manager for a single season, but resigned midway through 2021/22 after a disastrous run of results. Former Manchester United player Neil Mustoe then took over, steering the club away from danger (finishing in 17th place).

Mustoe achieved an 18th place finish at the end of the 2022/23 season, his first full campaign, before achieving a healthy 14th place in 2023/24, with a much improved squad.

FROM THE MANAGER



Good afternoon and welcome to Glevum Park this afternoon to all players, management, officials and supporters from Brimscombe & Thrupp FC.

This is our penultimate home Hellenic League game of the 2024/25 season and we are pleased to be joined by some guests today. I'd like to offer a huge welcome and thank you to all sponsors who are here (and those who cannot be here today) which helps us as a club throughout the season. This is something we are eternally grateful for.

Today's opponents can still stay up but will need to rely on results elsewhere over the next few weeks and will probably need three points today.

Due to this we are expecting a hard afternoon, and we need to match them in every department. We know we have the quality across the squad to win the game but all our victories have come from performances where the whole squad has performed, so that is the ask today.

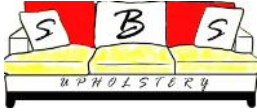

On (or around) this day in history...



Current records date back, fairly accurately, to the 2007/08 season and although there are a few gaps stopping us having a full set of data, it gives us the opportunity to include a new programme feature that allows us to reflect on days gone by and fixtures on, or around, today's date.

Since those records began, we've had four games on 15 March, and there have been other memorable fixtures around the date that we have selected to reflect on our fortunes on or around this particular day...

15 March 2008

There was a shock result for Tuffley Rovers in their home game with Gloucestershire County League strugglers Pucklechurch Sports, as the visitors left Glevum Park with all three points when Jon Wiltshire headed home in the 83rd minute. Earlier in the game Tuffley's Mark Harris had saved a penalty and the home side were also given the chance to take at least a point, right at the end of the game, when Gary Cornwall was upended in the box, but Warren Mann's penalty kick was wide of the target.

15 March 2011

In a game under floodlights at Glevum Park Tuffley Rovers ran out 4-3 winners against Hanham Athletic, as goals from Neil Griffiths, Scott Jones and two from Richard James secured the points by the odd goal in seven.

The game came a week after Rovers' triumph in their County Cup semi-final against Lydney Town and was the perfect recovery form a 3-1 defeat on their last Gloucestershire County League outing against Yate Town Reserves.

12 March 2013

Tuffley Rovers hosted Frampton United in a midweek Gloucestershire County League fixture and came away with a much needed three points, as they won 3-0 courtesy of goals from Dorian Colling, Richard James and Marcus Foxwell.

It was a first win in three for Rovers, who had seen consecutive draws since their last victory over Thornbury Town three weeks earlier, and extended their lead at the top of the table to five points.

15 March 2014

Goals from Shayne Bradley and Mark Ford proved sufficient to secure all three points for Doug Foxwell's Tuffley Rovers side, as they returned from Carterton with a 2-1 win

in the UHlsport Hellenic League, Division One (West). For Rovers this was a third consecutive victory, with their run built around Bradley's prowess in front of goal, with the former Southampton striker scoring for the third consecutive game and netting his eleventh of the season in the process.

Marcus Foxwell scored a penalty, and the only goal for the game, to help Tuffley Rovers secure all three points at home to Tytherington Rocks, making it thirteen league games unbeaten in the process, as Warren Evans' side kept up their push for promotion from the UHlsport Hellenic League Division One (West).

15 March 2016

Another competitive fixture between Gloucester rivals Longlevens and Tuffley Rovers ended with the visitors leaving Glevum Park with all three points, courtesy of a 2-1 win.

Brett James and Ed Smyllie both scored in the first half, to make it 1-1 at the interval, but the game was ultimately decided by Brad Martin's second half goal, as Rovers continued to search for a first point under Caretaker Manager Shayne Bradley.

The defeat left Rovers perilously close to the relegation zone in the UHlsport Hellenic League Premier Division, whilst it offered Longlevens another valuable win as they moved into a top-ten position.

9 March 2019



League-leaders Brimscombe arrived at Glevum Park looking to continue their title challenge, but a single goal settled this match in the hosts' favour thanks to a heroic defensive performance.

Luke Merchant, Macaulay Herbert and Joel White were the catalysts for the victory, which was ultimately secured thanks to Jake Rhodes' first-half goal, after he poked the ball home from close range, having been played in by Kieran Alder. That goal was ultimately the difference between the two teams, as Rovers continued their battle to move away from the relegation places, and their visitors were left to rue a defeat that could seriously damage their title ambitions.

Our last home game saw us play a Roman Glass St. George side with two former Football League players in the opposition line-up, as Chris Lines (who played in the Championship for Sheffield Wednesday, alongside in excess 300 appearances for Bristol Rovers) and Jennison Myrie-Williams (over 100 appearances for Port Vale, amidst a career spent in the EFL and National League) lined up for the visitors.



After the game, one supporter asked me if we had any former Football League players and I had to point to Neil Mustoe's time in the professional game, as well as one of our former players, Shayne Bradley, who made four Premier League appearances for Southampton in the 1998/99 and 1999/2000 seasons, before moving on to a host of EFL clubs, such as Mansfield Town, Chesterfield and Lincoln City.

BRIMSCOMBE & THRUPP HISTORY



Brimscombe FC

Brimscombe Football Club was established in 1886. In 1894 they were founder members of the Mid-Gloucestershire League, and played the first match in the league's history on 29 September against Stroud. In 1902 they switched to the new Stroud & District League and were its inaugural champions. They finished as runners-up in 1903–04, 1904–05 and 1905–06 before winning it again in 1906–07 and 1907–08. After twice finishing third, Brimscombe were runners-up again in 1910–11 and 1911–12. They won a fourth league title in 1912–13.

After World War I Brimscombe competed in the North Gloucestershire League, finishing as runners-up in 1919–20. They were founder members of the Gloucestershire Northern Senior League in 1922, and its first champions. They won the league again in 1930–31, having finished second-bottom of the table the previous season. In 1946–47 they finished as runners-up, and were champions the following season. In 1968 the club switched to the Gloucestershire County League, finishing bottom of the table in their first season. After finishing bottom again in 1972–73, the club left the league.

Brimscombe & Thrupp

In the 1970s the club merged with Thrupp to form Brimscombe & Thrupp. They rejoined the Gloucestershire County League in 1985, but left after finishing bottom in 1988–89.[5] The club returned to the Gloucestershire Northern Senior League, and after finishing as Division One runners-up in 2008–09, they moved up to the Gloucestershire County League for a third time.[5] After winning the County League in 2010–11, the club were promoted to Division One West of the Hellenic League. They won the division in 2012–13, earning promotion to the Premier Division.[5] The following season saw them win both the Supplementary and Floodlit Cups.[6] In 2017–18 the club won the Gloucestershire Challenge Trophy, beating Bitton 3–1 in the final.[7]

The club has stayed in the Premier Division since being promoted and came close to moving up in the 2018/19 season, when they finished second after taking the league title challenge to the final day, only to be pushed into second place when Wantage Town beat Windsor to secure the title.
