ACTION PLAN FOR SAFE ADMISSION OF SPECTATORS

1. Admittance to Glevum Park is only permitted on the basis that the conditions in this notice are fully complied with. Any failure to observe these conditions will result in admittance being denied and/or individuals being asked to leave the site.
2. Until further notice, any limitation on total spectator numbers, as mandated by the Department for Culture, Media & Sport (DCMS) and Football Association (FA) will be strictly observed.
3. Wherever possible, anyone attending Glevum Park will either scan the NHS App QR Code on entry or provide their contact details, to ensure compliance with Test & Trace requirements are captured. Where this is not possible, written details should be provided to our volunteers on entry to the site.
4. No individual should attend who has Covid symptoms of: a high temperature (above 37.8C), or any other symptoms. Temperature checks will be undertaken before access is permitted and *Test & Trace* measures will be in place at all times.
5. *Test & Trace* information provided direct to Tuffley Rovers (not using the NHS App) will be held for a period of 21 days from the date of the fixture.
6. Supporters, parents, and other spectators should remain socially distanced whilst attending events and throughout fixtures. Spectator groups must be restricted to discrete six-person gathering limits and spread out in line with wider Government guidance.
7. Social distancing requirements shall be observed at all times, whether in the bar, when serving post-match refreshments or on exiting the site.
8. Our bar and other hospitality areas will be take-away only, although goods supplied or purchased may be consumed on-site. There will be no seating available in the bar on match-days.
9. Appropriate markings will be in place, to advise spectators of arrangements for entry and exit to/from the site.
10. Access to spectator toilet facilities will be limited, with no more than one person provided access to each room at any time.

11. Supplies of sanitiser will be provided around the key areas of the ground and maintained throughout.
12. Access to the bar and food service areas will be controlled by one-way systems, with social distancing arrangements in place.
13. Regular announcements will be made on the tannoy at the ground to remind spectators of their responsibilities.
14. Everyone is asked to follow any advice in relation to exiting the site. Please treat our volunteers with respect at all times.
15. Where one-way systems are in place they should be observed at all times.
